OFFICIAL NOTICE OF CANDIDATE NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION

To avoid election challenges at the local level, OEA members/leaders must conduct elections in accordance with the Ohio Education Association Manual for the Conduct of Local Association Elections and the Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreements. Local leaders responsible for conducting elections should pay special attention to sections dealing with Notice of Nominations and Notice of Elections. Elections for OEA and NEA delegates are subject to specific Landrum-Griffin requirements, including mailing the notice of elections to each member's last known address at least 15 days prior to the election.
