## NOTES: Senate Legislative Scorecard

- <sup>1</sup>HB 21 would improve charter student residency verification. OEA supports this bill. It passed the House 94-0 and passed the Senate 32-0.
- <sup>2</sup>HB 87 requires misspent public funds recovered from charter schools to be returned to school districts. OEA supports this bill. It passed the Senate 30-2.
- <sup>3</sup>An amendment to HB 87 was offered on the Senate Floor to extend alternative graduation pathways for two years. OEA supports this amendment. It was tabled by a vote of 21-11.
- <sup>4</sup>SB 39 strengthens charter e-school accountability and transparency. OEA supports this bill.
- <sup>5</sup>SB 85 would greatly expand private school vouchers in the state. OEA opposes this bill.
- <sup>6</sup>SB 240 would improve the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System (OTES) based on recommendations of the Educator Standards Board. OEA supports this bill.
- <sup>7</sup>SB 246 would limit out-of-school suspensions and expulsions for K-3 students for most non-violent incidents and require schools to implement a positive behavior intervention and support framework (PBIS). OEA supports this bill.
