Ohio's student centered, adequate and predictable Fair School Funding Plan was built on real student needs—yet the Ohio House's proposal:

- Shortchanges public schools by \$2.75 billion by scrapping the Fair School Funding Plan.
- Caps local school districts carryover reserves at 30%.
- Revives unconstitutional and arbitrary budgeting.

Our Key Concerns

Equity & Evidence

The Fair School Funding Plan reflects bipartisan research on the true cost of educating every Ohio student. The House plan ditches that work for a one-size-fitsall formula that leaves most districts with only an extra \$50 per student over the next two years.

Loss of Local Control

A 30% carryover cap and rigid formula strip districts of budget flexibility—forcing more frequent levies instead of empowering local solutions.

Student Success

Only a predictable, student centered, and needs-based formula like the Fair School Funding Plan ensures stable staffing, wrap-around supports, and quality programs for all students, including for our most vulnerable learners.
